White Chicken Chili



Ingredients

1 Cup cooked and shredded chicken, or 2 raw boneless, skinless chicken breasts
1 4 oz Can diced green chiles
1 14 oz Can Great Northern beans, drained and rinsed
1 14 oz Can corn, drained
4 Cups Chicken broth
2 Teaspoons garlic powder
2 Teaspoons onion powder
1 Teaspoon cumin
1 Teaspoon chili powder
1 Cup Sour Cream

OPTIONAL TOPPINGS

Shredded cheese
Diced avocado
Sliced jalapenos
Fresh chopped cilantro
Tortilla strips

Slow Cooker

Instructions

In your crockpot, add all of the ingredients, except the sour cream. Stir to combine. Cook on low for 4 hours or on high for 2 hours if using precooked chicken. If using raw chicken, cook on low for 6 hours, or high for 4 hours. Before serving, stir in the sour cream. Serve with cheese, sliced jalapenos, avocado, cilantro and tortilla strips.
